any of the moneys of the said town; and may require such bond from such officials as they may deem advisable.

Sec. 17. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith in so far as they relate to the town of Presque Isle, in the county of Aroostook, are hereby repealed.

Sec. 18. Ratification. This act shall not become operative until it is ratified by said town of Presque Isle, at an annual town meeting or at a special town meeting called for that purpose by an appropriate article inserted in the call for said meeting, prior to April one, nineteen hundred thirty-three. Such vote shall be by check list and this act when so ratified shall take effect on the third Monday in March next following said ratification.

Sec. 19. Town may discontinue act by vote. This act shall become immediately and thenceforth inoperative from the time of the adoption of a vote to that effect by a majority of the legally qualified voters of the town at any regular annual town meeting, if an appropriate article is inserted in the call for said meeting. Such vote shall be by check list.

Chapter 101.

AN ACT amending "An Act to Incorporate the Bethel Water Company."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1889, c. 378, sec. 2; relating to the Bethel Water Company, amended. Section two of chapter three hundred seventy-eight of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred eighty-nine is amended by striking out "not exceeding sixty thousand dollars," so that said section shall read as follows:

Sec. 2. May hold real estate. Said corporation for said purposes, may hold real and personal estate necessary and convenient therefor.
