Chapter 3.

RESOLVE, in Favor of M. Isabel Libby of Saco.

M. Isabel Libby, teacher's pension; Resolved: That there be allowed and paid, out of the appropriation for teachers' pensions, to M. Isabel Libby, of Saco, in the county of York, the sum of five hundred dollars per year, during the lifetime of the said Libby, the sum to be paid in quarterly installments.

Approved February 27, 1931.

Chapter 4.

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey a Certain Lot of Land to Edmund B. Lapointe.

Conveyance of certain land authorized; Resolved: That the forest commissioner be and hereby is authorized to convey the interest of the state in lot number fifteen in township A, range five, west of the east line of the state in Aroostook county, in consideration of payment by said Edmund B. Lapointe to the state the sum equal to the amount of all taxes duly assessed against said lot by the state together with the interest thereon and such costs as have been paid by the state, the amount to be determined by the said forest commissioner.

Chapter 5.

RESOLVE, in Favor of Nellie F. Hill of Saco.

Nellie F. Hill; teacher's pension; Resolved: That there be allowed and paid, out of the appropriation for teachers' pensions, to Nellie F. Hill of Saco, in the county of York, the sum of five hundred dollars per year, during the lifetime of the said Hill, the sum to be paid in quarterly installments.

Chapter 6.

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Sell Lands in St. Francis Plantation, Aroostook County.

Sale of certain state lands authorized; Resolved: That the forest commissioner be and hereby is authorized to sell and convey to actual settlers
