Chapter 16.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Carl Newton of Lewiston.

Carl Newton; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Carl Newton, of Lewiston, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Chapter 17.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Florence H. Baker of Liberty.

Florence H. Baker; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of fifteen dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Florence H. Baker, of Liberty, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Chapter 18.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Lottie McFarland of Searsmont.

Lottie McFarland; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Lottie McFarland, of Searsmont, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.
