Chapter 19.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Nellie E. Turner of Auburn.

Nellie E. Turner; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Nellie E. Turner, of Auburn, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Approved March 6, 1931.

Chapter 20.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Heslyn York of Freedom.

Heslyn York; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of twenty dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Heslyn York, of Freedom, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Approved March 6, 1931.

Chapter 21.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Susie W. Morse of Auburn.

Susie W. Morse; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Susie W. Morse, of Auburn, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Chapter 22.

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Lorenzo D. Wright of Fairfield.

Lorenzo D. Wright; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of fifteen dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Lorenzo D. Wright, of Fairfield, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and
