## Chapter 35.

**RESOLVE**, for the Laying of the County Taxes for the Year Nineteen Hundred Thirty-two.

County taxes apportioned. Resolved: That the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and for other purposes of law, for the year nineteen hundred thirty-two.

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Fort Kent.

Fort Kent; reimbursed for money expended on a veteran. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one hundred forty-three dollars and eighty-seven cents, in favor of the town of Fort Kent, to reimburse it for money expended on account of Thomas Langille, a veteran.

### Chapter 37.

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Gladys Malcolm.

Mrs. Gladys Malcolm; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of forty-nine dollars to be paid to Mrs. Gladys Malcolm of Plymouth to reimburse her for medical expense for the care of her daughter, injured by a state ward, November twenty-four, nineteen hundred thirty.

### Chapter 38.

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of Horace Kelly, of Island Falls.

Horace Kelly, reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to Horace Kelly, commorant of Island Falls, the
