Chapter 90.**RESOLVE, in Favor of A. A. Abbott.**

A. A. Abbott; compensated for a claim. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of three hundred and thirty-five dollars to be paid to A. A. Abbott, of Cumberland Mills, to reimburse him for damage to his car by Henry Wood, a state ward: This is settlement in full for claims against the state of Maine.

Chapter 91.**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Milford.**

Milford; compensated for porcupine bounties. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of three hundred and twenty-three dollars and seventy-five cents to be paid to the town of Milford as a full and final settlement of claims against the state of Maine for reimbursement of porcupine bounties.

Chapter 92.**RESOLVE, in Favor of Eugene H. Flint, of Monson.**

E. H. Flint; compensated for injuries. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand five hundred and sixty dollars to reimburse Eugene H. Flint, of Monson for injuries received while in the employ of the highway department. This is a settlement in full of all claims against the state of Maine.

Chapter 93.**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium for the Construction and Equipment of a School House.**

Central Maine Sanatorium; appropriation for a School House. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated for the Central Maine Sanatorium the sum of eight thousand dollars for the construction and
