Chapter 99.

RESOLVE, In Favor of the Frontier Water Company.

Claim of Frontier Water Company settled. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars to be paid to the Frontier Water Company, a Maine corporation located in Fort Fairfield, Aroostook county, to compensate it for expense and damage occasioned by the rebuilding of a state highway in Fort Fairfield. This money is to be paid from the general funds of the highway commission. This is a full and final settlement of all claims against the state of Maine.

Approved April 2, 1931.

Chapter 100.

RESOLVE, Authorizing Commissioner of Fisheries and Game to Settle Damages with Charles Huff, of Topsfield.

Charles Huff; to be compensated; adjustment by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized to adjust the damages to Charles Huff, of Topsfield, caused by loss and damages by foxes, said damages to be paid from funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

Approved April 2, 1931.

Chapter 101.

RESOLVE, in Favor of the State Military and Naval Children's Home.

State Military and Naval Children's Home; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the state military and naval children's home, the sum of five thousand dollars for the construction of an infirmary at said institution, the same to be taken from surplus revenue construction funds.
