CHAP. 104

Chapter 102.

RESOLVE, for the Purpose of Grading and Constructing a Sidewalk on State Street in Front of the State House Grounds.

Sidewalk in front of State House grounds, appropriation for. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated a sum of money not to exceed fifteen hundred dollars for the purpose of grading and constructing a cement sidewalk along State street in front of the grounds of the State House, extending southerly from Capitol street to the driveway leading to the State Highway building, the same to be expended under the direction of the superintendent of public buildings, and he is hereby authorized to make arrangements with the city of Augusta, the expense to be borne two-thirds by the state and one-third by the city, but the state's part to be limited as aforesaid.

Chapter 103.

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Washburn.

Washburn; appropriation for, from fund for maintenance of bridges. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, from funds available for maintenance of bridges, the sum of two thousand dollars, to be used in repairing the bridge over the Aroostook river, in the town of Washburn, the work to be done under the supervision of the state highway commission.

Chapter 104.

RESOLVE, For the Construction, Maintenance and Repair of Roads, Bridges and Ferries.

Emergency Preamble. Whereas, the highways and bridges hereinafter mentioned can be built and repaired to much better advantage to the state if the contracts therefor are let early in the season and the work begun as soon as possible, and

Whereas, money for such building and repairs cannot be used until the funds provided by this resolve become available and loss and inconvenience will result if such work is not started early in the season, and
