For screening the outlet of Nash's Lake, in the county of Washington, one hundred dollars,	100.00
For reimbursing North and East Pond Fish and Game Association, for one half of expense of installing a screen at the outlet of East Pond, in Smithfield (screen already installed) one hundred and sixty two dollars and fifty cents,	162.50
For screening the outlet of Watchic Lake, in Standish, two hundred and fifty dollars,	250.00
For reimbursing the Bauneg Beg Fish Screen Assn., for one half of expense of installing a screen at Bauneg Beg Pond, in North Berwick (screen already installed) two hundred twenty-six dollars and eighty-three cents,	226.83
For screening the outlet of Stetson Pond, in Stetson, three hundred dollars,	300.00
For screening the outlet of Orneville Pond, in Orneville in Piscataquis county, one hundred sixty dollars,	160.00

Chapter 111.

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Remodel, Rebuild and Repair the Fish Ways in the St. Croix River in Calais, County of Washington.

Fish way in St. Croix river; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of one thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated, to be taken from the appropriation for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game, to be expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, to remodel, rebuild and repair the fish way in the Union dam and the fish way in the so-called Cotton Mill dam in the St. Croix river in Calais, county

of Washington, and the commissioner of inland fisheries and game shall have both said fish ways remodeled, rebuilt or repaired as he shall deem necessary, during the summer of nineteen hundred thirty-one.

This appropriation to be made with the proviso that the state will pay one thousand dollars toward the remodelling, repairing and rebuilding of fish ways in the St. Croix river, at Calais, if the Dominion government, or the government of the province of New Brunswick, will pay a like amount towards this work.

Chapter 112.

RESOLVE, in Favor of Eustis Road.

State highway leading from Eustis. Resolved: That there be appropriated the sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending December thirty-one, nineteen hundred thirty-one and the sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending December thirty-one, nineteen hundred thirty-two, to aid in improving the state highway leading from Eustis, in the county of Franklin, to the boundary line between the state of Maine and the Dominion of Canada at a place near the village of Woburn, in said Canada; said funds to come from the highway general funds.

Chapter 113.

RESOLVE, in Favor of Clerks, Stenographers, Messengers of the Several Committees of the Eighty-fifth Legislature.

Clerks, stenographers, etc., of legislative committees, compensation of. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of nine thousand, two hundred and forty dollars, to be paid to the persons named in the following schedule from the appropriation for contingent expenses of committees and contingent expenses of the Eighty-fifth Legislature.
