Chapter 138.

RESOLVE, on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives of the Eighty-fifth Legislature.

Pay roll of the house of representatives. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one hundred five thousand, one hundred and eighty-three dollars, to be paid to the persons named in the following pay roll according to the sum set against the name of each.
