CHAP. 128

#### Chapter 125.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Eleanor C. Ryder, of Newport.

Pension provided for Eleanor C. Ryder, of Newport. Resolved: That a pension of \$8 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Eleanor C. Ryder, of Newport, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

#### Chapter 126.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Leland Palmer, of Carmel.

Pension provided for L'eland Palmer. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Leland Palmer, of Carmel, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

#### Chapter 127.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Susie May Harding, of Hampden.

Pension provided for Susie May Harding. Resolved: That a pension of \$20 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Susie May Harding, of Hampden, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.
