Any school for whose benefit an appropriation is made herein from the adjustment fund that did not share in the per capita distribution during the fiscal years 1931-32 and 1932-33 that becomes entitled to and receives money under the per capita distribution during the fiscal years 1933-34 and 1934-35 shall receive from the adjustment fund an amount equal to the appropriation herein provided for that particular school less the amount received under the per capita allowance.

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### Chapter 187.

**RESOLVE, Regulating the Taking of Smelts in the York River and Smelt Brook in the Towns of York and Eliot, in York County.**

Taking of smelts in the York river and Smelt brook, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation making it unlawful to take smelts in the York river and Smelt brook and their tributaries in the towns of York and Eliot above the junction of the York river and Smelt brook.

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### Chapter 188.

**RESOLVE, in Favor of Kineowatha Camps Inc., of Wilton, to Reimburse for Removal of Floating Bog, on Wilson Lake.**

Kineowatha Camps Inc. compensated for removal of floating bog. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$500, to be paid Kineowatha Camps Inc., of Wilton, Maine, as a settlement in full for all claims against the state of Maine, for removal of floating bog on the shores of Wilson lake in the town of Wilton, said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.
