Chapter 189.

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Road Leading from Greenville to Rockwood.

Appropriation for road from Greenville to Rockwood. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1934 and \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1935 for the construction of a highway leading from Greenville to Rockwood, to continue the work already begun on said highway. Any unexpended balance at the end of each fiscal year, shall be available for construction of the same road during any succeeding fiscal year.

Funds shall be taken for this purpose from the general highway fund.

Chapter 190.

RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Carrie E. Fitch.

Pension for Carrie E. Fitch, repealed. Resolved: That that part of chapter 98 of the resolves of 1931 which provides for a state pension for Carrie E. Fitch be, and hereby is, repealed.

Chapter 191.

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Addie L. Coombs, of Montville.

Pension for Addie L. Coombs, increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Addie L. Coombs, of Montville, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which she is now receiving.
