CHAP. 198

Chapter 197.

RESOLVE, for the Laying of the County Taxes for the Year Nineteen Hundred Thirty-four.

County taxes apportioned. Resolved: That the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and for other purposes of law, for the year nineteen hundred and thirty-four.
