**Chapter 225.****RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles Springer, of Hartland.**

**Charles Springer compensated for accident. Resolved:** That there be and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$250 to be paid to Charles Springer, of Hartland, to compensate him for injuries received while in the employ of the state highway department, to be paid from the highway fund.

**Chapter 226.****RESOLVE, in Favor of Clerks and Stenographers of the Several Committees of the Eighty-sixth Legislature for the December Special Session.**
