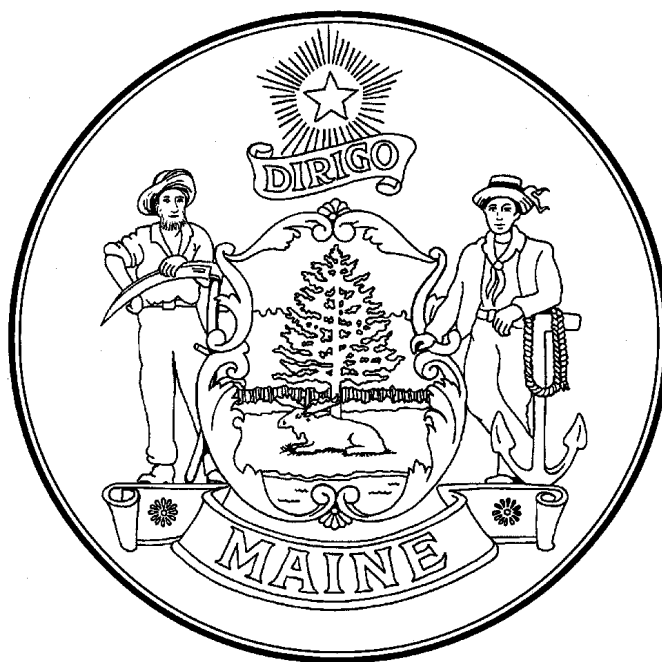

Chapter 53.

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Danforth Water Company.

Reimbursement. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$183.39 to be paid the Danforth Water Company of Danforth, to reimburse it for taxes paid upon internal combustion engine fuel, said sum to be paid from the funds collected from the internal combustion engine fuel tax.

Chapter 54.

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Castine.

Town of Castine; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$450 to be paid to the state aid joint fund of the town of Castine to reimburse said fund for money taken for payment of a damage claim, said sum to be paid from general highway funds.

Approved March 22, 1935.

Chapter 55.

RESOLVE, in Favor of Harvey I. Dillingham for Damage Inflicted to Sheep by Dogs.

Harvey I. Dillingham, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$30 to be paid to Harvey I. Dillingham, of Auburn, as a settlement in full for all claims against the state of Maine by reason of loss of sheep killed, and others in his flock damaged, by dogs, said sum to be paid from funds received from dog licenses.

Chapter 56.

RESOLVE, in Favor of Augustus S. Burke and R. Bourbeau, of Fairfield, to Compensate Them for Land Taken for Sewer Appurtenant to Central Maine Sanatorium.

Augustus S. Burke and R. Bourbeau, of Fairfield, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$75, to be paid to Augustus S. Burke and R. Bourbeau, of Fairfield, to compensate
