Chapter 113.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Winnifred Parker of Presque Isle.

Winnifred Parker; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Winnifred Parker, of Presque Isle. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1935, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Chapter 114.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Charles W. Shorey, of Waldo.

Retirement pension for Charles W. Shorey. Resolved: That Charles W. Shorey of Waldo, a former employee of the State Highway Department, is hereby made eligible to receive a retirement pension under the provisions of sections 227-230 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933.

Chapter 115.

RESOLVE, Relative to Season and Bag Limit on Smelts.

Season and bag limit on smelts, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized to extend the open season, or increase the daily bag limit, on smelts in inland waters, upon petition and hearing as provided by chapter 38, of the revised statutes, as amended.

Chapter 116.

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Pay Pauper Claims Heretofore Approved by the Committee on Claims.

Claims, appropriation in payment of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to the cities, towns, counties and persons hereinafter named the sums set opposite their respective names, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of \$24,525.95, being the amounts recommended by the committee on claims to be paid on claims presented to said committee, said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

Chapter 117.

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Pay the Claim of Frank D. and Evelyn C. Goodwin, of Hermon, Against the State of Maine.

Frank D. and Evelyn C. Goodwin; compensated for a claim against the state. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$1700 to be paid to Frank D. and Evelyn C. Goodwin, of Hermon, as a full and final settlement of all claims against the state of Maine for the loss of buildings, furniture and personal property, etc., caused by a fire set by Philip Henry, a state ward, said sum to be paid from the general state funds.
