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### Chapter 130.

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Vassalboro.

**Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1936, the sum of \$500 in favor of the town of Vassalboro, to aid in repairing and rebuilding the road beginning at the North Belfast road, and running southerly to the Windsor town line; commonly known as the Taylor road, or the Three Mile Pond road, in the town of Vassalboro, the same to be paid from the general highway fund.

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### Chapter 131.

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Oakland.

**Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1936, in favor of the town of Oakland, the sum of \$500 to aid in repairing the East Pond road, so-called, beginning at Tyler's Corner and extending to the Smithfield town line, same to be paid from the general highway fund.
