Chapter 6

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interests of the State in a Certain Lot of Land to Elmer E. Newbert, Trustee.

Conveyance of certain land, authorized. Resolved: That the forest commissioner as land agent be, and hereby is, authorized to convey the interest of the state in an undivided $\frac{1}{4}$ part of the south half of township 3, range 6, B. K. P. W. K. R. (Upper Enchanted Township), according to a survey and plan of said township made and returned to the land office of the state of Maine by S. F. Weston et als in 1850; also the right to cut and carry away timber and grass from an undivided $\frac{1}{6}$ part of the reserved lands on said south half of said township, which lands and rights were sold for taxes of the year 1931, to Elmer E. Newbert, Trustee under indenture of November 16, 1932 for the benefit of the creditors of W. D. Hutchins, in consideration of the payment by said Elmer E. Newbert, Trustee of the sum of \$1,298.27, said payment representing the total of the state, county and district taxes on said property and rights for the years 1931 to 1936, both inclusive, together with interest thereon to February 1, 1937.

Chapter 7

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Land in the County of Aroostook.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Willie Tardif of St. Agatha, Aroostook county, undivided half of lot 293, 93 acres, in T. 17, R. 5, west of the east line of the state, Aroostook county.
