Chapter 121

RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold L. Wentworth of Cornish.

Harold L. Wentworth; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of Harold L. Wentworth, of Cornish, the sum of \$37.73 as a full and final settlement for claims against the state for damage to his car by deer; to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

Chapter 122

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Eddington.

Town of Eddington; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$1,197.86 to be paid to the town of Eddington, for extra expense incurred by the delay of the state on the repair of the bridge on Bradley road, so-called; said sum to be paid from the general highway funds.

Chapter 123

RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry L. Martin, of Boston, Massachusetts.

Henry L. Martin; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Henry L. Martin, of Boston, Massachusetts, the sum of \$50 as a full and final settlement for claims against the state for damage to his car by deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

Chapter 124

RESOLVE, in Favor of Rowland Batchelder, of Augusta.

Rowland Batchelder; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of Rowland Batchelder, of Augusta, the sum of \$60 as a full and final settlement for all claims against the state for damage to his car by moose; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.
