CHAP. 151

Constitutionality of this resolve. Resolved: That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolve is held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolve.

Chapter 150

RESOLVE, Relating to Smelt Fishing in Hancock County.

Smelt fishing in Hancock county, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to repeal rule and regulation numbered 53, as published in the official rules and regulations of the department and to issue the following rule and regulation:

'There is hereby created an open time in which it shall be lawful to fish for and take smelts from the tide waters within the limits of the towns of Stonington, Brooklin and Deer Isle, in the county of Hancock, between the 1st day of September and the 15th day of April. Any fish so taken from said waters may be offered for sale and sold within the state or shipped to such places out of the state as the owner may designate.'
