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against the inhabitants of said city, town or plantation has expired, the court shall fix the time for hearing upon the claims so filed, which hearing may be adjourned from time to time, to determine the validity of the obligation and the amount thereof. Any party grieved by the finding of said court may appeal to the next term of the superior court to be held in the county where such city, town or plantation is located. The judgment of the single justice shall be binding upon all parties unless appealed from All obligations determined by said court not to be valid as aforesaid. claims against the inhabitants of said city, town or plantation shall be forever barred in any action against the inhabitants of said city, town or plantation and the finding of the court may be pleaded as a bar to any action brought upon said claim or claims. All indebtedness adjudicated to be valid against the inhabitants of said city, town or plantation by the finding of the single justice or on appeal, if such appeal is taken by either party, shall be thereafter considered as a valid outstanding indebtedness against the inhabitants of said city, town or plantation.'

AN ACT Relating to Payment to the County Law Library of York County.

Chapter 57

AN ACT Relating to the Treasurer of the University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 114, amended. Section 114 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following is enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 114. Duties and powers of treasurer. The treasurer shall receive and have custody of all moneys received for the University of Maine, and
