Chapter 104

AN ACT to Amend the Law Relating to Unemployment Compensation, with Regard to Gratuities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1935, c. 192, § 19, amended. Subsection (m) of section 19 of chapter 192 of the public laws of 1935, as amended by section 11 of chapter 228 of the public laws of 1937, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- '(m) "Wages" means all remuneration payable for personal services, including commissions and bonuses and the cash value of all remuneration payable in any medium other than cash. Gratuities customarily received by an individual in the course of his employment from persons other than his employing unit shall be treated as remuneration payable by his employing unit. The reasonable cash value of remuneration payable in any medium other than cash, and the reasonable amount of gratuities, shall be estimated and determined in accordance with rules prescribed by the commission.'

Chapter 105

AN ACT to Regulate the Sale of Commercial Fertilizer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
