#### Chapter 6

RESOLVE, Designating The Governor Barrows Rearing Station.

Governor Barrows Rearing Station, designated. Resolved: That the new lobster rearing station now under construction at Boothbay Harbor be and hereby is designated as "The Governor Barrows Rearing Station."

Approved March 2, 1939.

#### Chapter 7

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Sale of State's Interest in Certain Lands, in Township No. 17.

Sale of certain state land, authorized. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell and convey to Mrs. Octave Cyr, of St. Agatha, for the sum of \$166.84, whatever interest the state may have in the following described property, to wit:

'Situate in township number seventeen (17), range four (4), W. E. L. S., county of Aroostook and state of Maine, to wit: A part of lot number four (4) twenty (20) rods in width throughout its entire length from the waters of Long Lake to rear line of said lot and being situate between land of Marie Albert on the northwestern side and land formerly owned by Hypolite Albert on the southeastern side.'

#### Chapter 8

RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Convey Certain Land to Alex J. Latno, of Old Town.

Forestry department authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey the following described lot to Alex J. Latno, of Old Town, for the sum of \$66.51: 143 acres of land in township I North Division (formerly Summit Plantation) Penobscot county.
