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### Chapter 31

#### RESOLVE, for the Transfer of Certain Monies in the Hands of the Bangor State Hospital and the Augusta State Hospital.

Certain monies transferred. Resolved: That the sum of \$2,771 now in the possession of the treasurer of the Bangor State Hospital, representing the accumulation of small amounts of cash left in the hospital by former deceased and discharged patients; and that the sums of \$1,881.53 and \$3,194.83 now in the possession of the treasurer of the Augusta State Hospital, representing the accumulation of small amounts of cash and accrued savings account interest thereon, left in the hospital by former deceased and discharged patients, are hereby transferred to the general funds of the state.

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### Chapter 32

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of Alvah E. Spear, of Warren.

Alvah E. Spear; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$197.86, to be paid to Alvah E. Spear, of Warren, to compensate him in full for all claims against the state for damages done to his house by Edward Whalen, a paroled convict from the state prison; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

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### Chapter 33

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of William A. Moran, of Bangor.

William A. Moran; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$40.17 to be paid to William A. Moran, of Bangor, as a full and final settlement for all claims against the state for damage to his lumber camps by bear; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.
