Chapter 52

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Town of East Machias to Close the West Outlet of Gardners Lake.

West Outlet of Gardners lake, closed. Resolved: That the town of East Machias be, and hereby is, authorized to fill in and close the West Outlet of Gardners lake, in the town of East Machias, in the course of reconstruction of the road leading from Jacksonville to Chase's Mills, in said town of East Machias.

Chapter 53

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Sell Land on Muscongus Island.

Forest commissioner authorized to sell certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell and convey to The First National Bank, of Damariscotta, the interest of the state in a I acre and 3 acre lots of land with buildings thereon, on Muscongus Island (Loudville), Lincoln county, for the amount due to the state for taxes and costs.

Chapter 54

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land in Aroostook County to Hector Martin.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Hector Martin of Frenchville, the interest of the state in 85 acres of land in lot 3 in township 17, range 4, W.E.L.S., Aroostook county, for the sum of \$53.48.
