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## Chapter 4

### AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Leaving Scene of Accident.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 29, § 87, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 87 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Whoever goes away without stopping and making himself known after causing injury to any person or property, or uses a motor vehicle without authority from its owner, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200, or by imprisonment for a term of not more than ~~three~~ 9 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment; and if any person be convicted the second time for a violation of this section, he shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$200 and not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'

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## Chapter 5

### AN ACT Relating to Municipal Ordinances.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 5, § 136, amended. Paragraph II of section 136 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'II. For establishing police regulations, for the prevention of crime, protection of property, and preservation of good order, and to regulate the use and manner of the use of bicycles in the streets ~~in the night time.~~'

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## Chapter 6

### AN ACT Relating to Deputy Clerk of Courts in Penobscot County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 125, § 41, amended. The 14th line of section 41 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 73 of the public laws of 1935 and chapter 118 of the public laws of 1937, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Penobscot, \$2500; deputy clerk of courts, ~~\$1350~~ \$1600.'
