

#### CHAP. 67

the certificate provided for above or the solemnization of marriage contrary to this chapter shall forfeit \$100. The clerk of any town or his deputy who intentionally violates the provisions of this section or falsely states the residence of either party named in the certificate above mentioned shall forfeit \$20 for each offense.'

- Sec. 3. P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 62-A, amended. Section 62-A of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933, which was enacted by section 3 of chapter 126 of the public laws of 1939, is hereby amended so that the fourth paragraph of said section shall read as follows:

'The license shall contain the information called for in the following form, so far as same is known to each person, one of whom shall subscribe to the truth of same in the presence of the clerk or one of his assistants, of that town or city in which they respectively reside the certificate of intentions of marriage is filed.'

#### Chapter 67

AN ACT to Regulate the Packing of Sardines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 41, § 79, amended. Section 79 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and inserting in place thereof the following:
- 'Sec. 79. Cans to be hermetically sealed and enamel lined. On all cans used for packing sardines there shall be used a compound lined gasket, or other adequate gasket as will hermetically seal the container. All cans used for packing sardines shall be enamel lined.'
