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## Chapter 87

### AN ACT Relating to the Office of the Register of Probate of Lincoln County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 40, amended. The 11th line of section 40 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~twelve hundred dollars~~ \$1500.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. That part of the 9th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 which relates to clerk hire in the office of register of probate of Lincoln county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of probate ~~one hundred sixty dollars~~ \$500.'

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## Chapter 88

### AN ACT Relating to Legal Documents.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 93, § 31-A, additional. Chapter 93 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 31-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 31-A. Penalty for simulating legal papers. No person shall send, deliver, mail, or in any manner cause to be sent, delivered or mailed to any person, firm or corporation, any paper or document simulating or intended to simulate a summons, complaint, writ or court process of any kind. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.'

### AN ACT Relating to Fees of Constables Enforcing the Dog License Law.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 5, § 163, amended. Section 163 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:
