Supplementary to the Acts and Resolves of the Regular Session

Sec. 4. P. L., 1941, c. 258, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 258 of the public laws of 1941 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. **Certain appropriations not to lapse.** The appropriations for state pauper assistance, old age assistance, aid to the blind and aid to dependent children shall be carrying accounts and all unexpended balances thereof remaining at the end of any fiscal year shall not lapse but shall be carried forward to the credit of the same account; except that any unexpended balance at the close of any fiscal year in the account for state pauper assistance beyond the actual commitments made at the close of the fiscal period may be lapsed by order of the governor and his council.'

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 330

AN ACT Relating to Standard Time During the Present Emergency.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, a state of war exists between the United States and Germany, Italy, Japan and other foreign countries; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature this fact creates an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and requires the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Standard time in Maine during present war emergency defined. Beginning at 2:00 A. M. on February 9, 1942 and continuing during the duration of the present war and 6 months after termination of the said war, the standard time in the state shall be advanced 1 hour.

Sec. 2. Duration of act. This act may be terminated at such time as the governor, by proclamation, or the legislature, by resolution, may direct. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions herein are hereby suspended during the effective period of this act.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
