Private and Special Laws

As Passed by the Ninetieth Legislature

(Effective July 26, 1941)

XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Salary of police officials. Police captains shall each receive a salary of ~~\$1,800~~ \$2470 per annum payable in equal weekly installments by the city treasurer. Inspectors shall each receive a salary of \$1,800 per annum payable in equal weekly installments by the city treasurer. The police clerk shall receive a salary not to exceed \$1,600 per annum payable in equal weekly installments by the city treasurer.'

## Chapter 46

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the City of Presque Isle.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 29, Art. IV, § 1, amended. Section 1 of Article IV of chapter 29 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'(c) All officers and boards appointed under this section except as otherwise provided in this chapter and except those whose terms of office are fixed by the public laws of the state of Maine shall hold office until the 1st Monday of January next following the date of their appointment and until their successors are appointed and qualified.'

## Chapter 47

AN ACT Relating to Employment and Salary of Deputy Clerk of Lewiston.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VI, § 1, amended. Section 1 of article VI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sentence: 'The city clerk may employ a chief clerk, who may serve as his deputy, at a salary to be determined by the board of finance.'

Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended to conform with the provisions of this act.
