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### Chapter 1

#### **RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Tributaries to Garland Pond.**

**Fishing in tributaries to Garland pond, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing the tributaries, wherever situated, to Garland pond in Sebec and Dover-Foxcroft, county of Piscataquis.

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### Chapter 2

#### **RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Grass Pond in the County of Somerset.**

**Fishing in Grass pond; regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Grass pond in Pierce Pond township, county of Somerset, to fishing with bait with a daily bag limit of 4 fish per person per day.
