Chapter 1

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Tributaries to Garland Pond.

Fishing in tributaries to Garland pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing the tributaries, wherever situated, to Garland pond in Sebec and Dover-Foxcroft, county of Piscataquis.

Chapter 2

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Grass Pond in the County of Somerset.

Fishing in Grass pond; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Grass pond in Pierce Pond township, county of Somerset, to fishing with bait with a daily bag limit of 4 fish per person per day.
