Chapter 22

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in East and West Richardson Ponds, in Oxford County.

Fishing in East and West Richardson ponds; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation making a daily bag limit of 4 fish to be taken from the East and West Richardson ponds, situated in Adamstown (T. 4, R. 2) and Lincoln plantation, in the county of Oxford. Tributaries closed.

Chapter 23

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Barker Pond.

Fishing in Barker pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Barker pond in Hiram and Sebago, counties of Oxford and Cumberland, to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring, and for all fish (except bass) during February and March.

Chapter 24

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Granger Pond.

Fishing in Granger pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Granger pond in Denmark, Oxford county, to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring, and for all fish (except bass) during February and March.
