Chapter 38

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Lincoln County Waters.

Fishing in certain Lincoln county waters, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation, opening Duck Puddle pond in Nobleboro and Waldoboro, Damariscotta lake, Little and Big Medomak ponds in Waldoboro, Cooks pond in Nobleboro and Big and Little Dyers pond in Jefferson, all in the county of Lincoln, to white perch fishing from April 1st to September 30th each year.

Approved March 8, 1941

Chapter 39

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Belgrade Chain of Lakes.

Fishing in Belgrade Chain of Lakes; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation that the length of small-mouth black bass that may be taken in the Belgrade Chain of Lakes be changed from 12 inches to 10 inches.

Chapter 40

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing on Great Lake in Belgrade.

Ice fishing in Great Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Great Lake in the Belgrade Chain to ice fishing on Saturdays during the months of January and February for pickerel and pike only.
