Chapter 44

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Tributaries to Twitchell Pond in Greenwood.

Fishing in tributaries to Twitchell pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, closing to all smelt fishing the tributaries, wherever situated, to Twitchell pond in Greenwood, county of Oxford.

Approved March 8, 1941

Chapter 45

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Waldo County.

Fishing in Waldo county, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, establishing April 1st as the opening date for fishing in Waldo county.

Approved March 8, 1941

Chapter 46

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Saco and Mousam Rivers.

Fishing in Saco and Mousam rivers, regulated. Resolved: That chapter 130 of the public laws of 1933 and chapter 178 of the resolves of 1933 are hereby repealed and that the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to repeal any rules and regulations issued thereunder.

Chapter 47

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to Convey the Interest of the State in Certain Land in Belgrade.

Sale of certain land authorized. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized to convey by a deed of quitclaim the interest of the state in a certain lot or parcel of land situate
