## Chapter 44

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Tributaries to Twitchell Pond in Greenwood.

Fishing in tributaries to Twitchell pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, closing to all smelt fishing the tributaries, wherever situated, to Twitchell pond in Greenwood, county of Oxford.

## Chapter 45

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Waldo County.

Fishing in Waldo county, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, establishing April 1st as the opening date for fishing in Waldo county.

## Chapter 46

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Saco and Mousam Rivers.

Fishing in Saco and Mousam rivers, regulated. Resolved: That chapter 130 of the public laws of 1933 and chapter 178 of the resolves of 1933 are hereby repealed and that the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to repeal any rules and regulations issued thereunder.

## Chapter 47

### RESOLVE, Authorizing the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to Convey the Interest of the State in Certain Land in Belgrade.

Sale of certain land authorized. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized to convey by a deed of quitclaim the interest of the state in a certain lot or parcel of land situate

in Belgrade in the county of Kennebec, bounded and described as follows: located from the west end of the old Bickford farm, so-called, beginning at the north side of town road leading from the State road to the Leslie Damren property, and at the said Damren's southeast corner, thence easterly along said town road to a 10 inch oak tree and iron stake, thence north  $13^{\circ}-15'$  east to a point one rod above high water level of pond, thence westerly along a line one rod above high water mark to Damren's east line, thence south  $13^{\circ}-15'$  west to the point of beginning and these two sides being parallel and 215 feet apart, to Leslie Damren of said Belgrade.

## Chapter 48

### RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Arlene Remick.

Mrs. Arlene Remick; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$100 as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state, to be paid to Mrs. Arlene Remick, of East Wilton, for damage to her car by a fox; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game department.

## Chapter 49

### RESOLVE, in Favor of Edward Doyle, of Fort Kent.

Edward Doyle; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$73.70 to be paid to Edward Doyle, of Fort Kent, as a full and final settlement for all claims against the state for all expenses incurred in the recommitment of Laura Corriveau to the women's reformatory, at Skowhegan; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.
