RESOLVES

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE

As Passed by the Ninetieth Legislature

(Effective July 26, 1941)

Chapter 50

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Blaine for Replacement of a Culvert.

Town of Blaine; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$189.66 to be paid to the town of Blaine as a settlement in full for monies and material furnished by the town of Blaine in replacement of a culvert; said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.

Approved March 14, 1941

Chapter 51

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Sullivan.

Town of Sullivan; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$601.60 to be paid from the general highway fund to the town of Sullivan to compensate it for the snow removal allowance that was not applied for in time under the law.

Approved March 14, 1941

Chapter 52

RESOLVE, Granting Bonus to Charles Story Crosman, of West Gardiner.

Charles Story Crosman granted state bonus. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, \$100 to be paid to Charles Story Crosman, of West Gardiner, as his World War bonus; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

Approved March 14, 1941

Chapter 53

RESOLVE, in Favor of Bion M. Rhoades of Topsfield.

Bion M. Rhoades; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$145.13 to be paid to Bion M. Rhoades, of Topsfield, as a full and final settlement for all claims against the state for damage to growing crops by deer; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.
