Chapter 54

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Mann's Mill Pond and Little Poverty Pond.

Fishing in Mann's Mill pond and Little Poverty pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue rules and regulations, opening Mann's Mill pond in Newfield and Little Poverty pond in Shapleigh in York county, to ice fishing for pickerel, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs, white perch and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring and for all fish (except bass) during February and March.

Approved March 14, 1941

Chapter 55

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Wilson Pond.

Fishing in Wilson pond; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Wilson pond, in Monmouth, county of Kennebec, to fishing for white perch from the time the ice is out until September 30th.

Approved March 14, 1941

Chapter 56

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Androscoggin County Waters.

Fishing in Androscoggin county waters, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing April 15th as the opening date on which it shall be legal to fish in the waters of Androscoggin county.
