Chapter 64

RESOLVE, in Favor of Knox Memorial Association, Inc., for Support and Maintenance of "Montpelier."

Knox Memorial Association, Inc., appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Knox Memorial Association, Inc., the sum of \$1000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, and the sum of \$1000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1943, to aid in the support and maintenance of "Montpelier," replica of the home of Major General Henry Knox, located at Thomaston, Maine. By this appropriation, it is not intended to encourage future financial aid.

Chapter 65

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land to Agnes Lapointe Plourd, of Frenchville.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Agnes Lapointe Plourd, of Frenchville, the interest of the state in a 77 acre parcel of land with buildings thereon in T. 17, R. 5, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county, for the sum of \$265.71.

Chapter 66

RESOLVE, Opening East Grand Lake in Weston to Ice Fishing.

East Grand lake; opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening East Grand lake in the town of Weston, Aroostook county, to ice fishing during the months of February and March of each year.
