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## Chapter 67

### RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Bear, Wayne and Upper Range Ponds.

Fishing in Bear, Wayne and Upper Range ponds, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Bear pond in Oxford and Androscoggin counties, Wayne pond in Kennebec and Androscoggin counties, and Upper Range pond in Cumberland and Androscoggin counties to fishing after April 15th of each year, under the general law.

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## Chapter 68

### RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land to Mrs. Myrtle Madden Hutchinson, of Old Town.

Forest commissioner to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Mrs. Myrtle Madden Hutchinson, of Old Town, the interest of the state in a farm lot of 130 acres in T. 32, M. D., Hancock county, for the sum of \$86.93.

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## Chapter 69

### RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Land to Clara Calder Johnston of Rockwood.

Forest commissioner to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Clara Calder Johnston, of Rockwood, the interest of the state in a 40 acre tract with buildings thereon in T. 1, R. 1, N. B. K. P., Somerset county, for the sum of \$180.59. The deed shall be withheld by the forest commissioner until the full amount of taxes in arrears is in the hands of the state tax assessor.
