(Effective July 26, 1941)

Chapter 70

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Clayton and Fish Lakes of the Fish River Chain of Lakes.

Fishing in Clayton and Fish lakes of the Fish River chain of lakes, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, establishing May 1st as the opening date on which it shall be legal to fish for salmon and trout in Clayton and Fish lakes of the Fish River chain of lakes in Aroostook county.

Approved March 24, 1941

Chapter 71

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Squa Pan Lake.

Fishing in Squa Pan lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to ice fishing for smelts from December 1st until the ice goes out in the spring, with 3 hooks per line not larger than No. 6, and not less than 3 nor more than 5 inches apart, Squa Pan Lake in townships 10 and 11, range 4 in the county of Aroostook.

Chapter 72

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Tacoma Chain of Lakes.

Ice fishing in Tacoma chain of lakes; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue the following rule and regulation:

Opening the Tacoma chain of lakes to ice fishing for pickerel and white perch only on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays of each week during the months of January, February and March.
