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### Chapter 73

**RESOLVE, Relating to the Maine Commission on Interstate Cooperation.**

Maine commission on interstate cooperation; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$700 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, and \$700 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1943, to be used in paying the expenses of the commission established by the provisions of chapter 250 of the public laws of 1939.

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### Chapter 74

**RESOLVE, in Favor of Procuring Testimonials for the Purpose of Marking the Unmarked Graves of Soldiers of the Revolutionary War.**

Marking of graves of soldiers of the Revolutionary War; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$150 be, and hereby is, appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, for the purpose of procuring testimonials to be used in marking the unmarked graves of the soldiers of the Revolutionary War; and be it further

Resolved: That with the approval of the governor and council, said sum shall be paid into the treasury of the "Sons of the American Revolution", with which they are hereby authorized to procure and distribute such number of markers as may, from time to time, be required for the purposes herein specified.

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### Chapter 75

**RESOLVE, in Favor of Fort McClary.**

Fort McClary; rehabilitated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1000 to be expended by the superintendent of buildings in rehabilitating Fort McClary, including the replacing of windows and doors, and shingling the building.
