## Chapter 82

**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land to Mrs. Grace E. Kelley.**

Forest commissioner to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Mrs. Grace E. Kelley the interest of the state in  $\frac{1}{4}$  of 9,180 acres of land in T. 4, R. 3, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county, for the sum of \$428.02.

## Chapter 83

**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land to Arthur Hobbs, Clyde Hobbs and Elsie Sealey, of Stratton.**

Forest commissioner to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Arthur Hobbs, Clyde Hobbs and Elsie Sealey, of Stratton, the interest of the state in  $\frac{133}{2313}$  of 299 acres in T. 4, R. 3, W. K. R., Franklin county, for the sum of \$7.47.

## Chapter 84

**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Pemaquid River.**

Fishing in Pemaquid river; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation that no fish shall be taken, except by hook and line, from the waters of Pemaquid river, above a line drawn from the most southerly end of Cardy's Point to the most southwesterly end of Old Fort Point.
