## Chapter 93

RESOLVE, in Favor of Blanche G. Cobb, of Lisbon.

Blanche G. Cobb; state pension. Resolved: That a pension be, and hereby is, granted to Blanche G. Cobb, of Lisbon, to be paid quarterly from the appropriation for teachers' pensions. Said pension shall begin 90 days after the adjournment of the legislature, and shall continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

## Chapter 94

RESOLVE, in Favor of Ella M. Jude, of Ellsworth.

Ella M. Jude; state pension. Resolved: That a pension be, and hereby is, granted to Ella M. Jude, of Ellsworth, to be paid quarterly from the appropriation for teachers' pensions. Said pension shall begin 90 days after the adjournment of the legislature, and shall continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

## Chapter 95

RESOLVE, in Favor of George Soctomah, Representative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

George Soctomah, compensation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated, to be paid to George Soctomah, representative of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians at the 90th legislature, the sum of \$200 for attendance, and \$44 for mileage; said sums to be paid immediately in full from the appropriation for legislative expenses.
