Chapter 110

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Fish River Chain of Lakes.

Fishing in Fish River Chain of Lakes, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue rules and regulations closing in the Fish River Chain of Lakes, to all fishing the following brooks and their tributaries:

Pennington Brook, Eagle Lake, T. 16, R. 6, T. 15, R. 6
 McLean Brook, T. 17, R. 4, T. 17, R. 5 and St. Agatha
 Paulette Brook, T. 17, R. 4, Grand Isle and Madawaska
 Mud Brook, T. 17, R. 3 and Stockholm
 Dickey Brook, Fort Kent, St. Agatha and T. 17, R. 5
 Dimock Brook, New Canada, T. 17, R. 5, T. 16, R. 5
 California Brook, New Canada, T. 17, R. 5, T. 16, R. 5
 Halfway Brook, T. 16, R. 6, T. 16, R. 5
 First of Three Brooks, T. 15, R. 6, T. 16, R. 6
 Middle of Three Brooks, T. 16, R. 5, T. 15, R. 5, T. 15, R. 6
 Last of Three Brooks, T. 16, R. 5, T. 15, R. 5.

Chapter 111

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Charleston.

Town of Charleston; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$696.50 to be paid to the town of Charleston, to reimburse said town for costs and taxes due on a farm upon which the Maine Farm Loan Commission foreclosed a mortgage, and later leased; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.
