Chapter 119

RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Amelia Rittal.

Resolves, 1933, c. 182, repealed. Resolved: That chapter 182 of the resolves of 1933, providing for a state pension for Amelia Rittal, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.

Chapter 120

RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Mary Kane.

Resolves, 1939, c. 77, repealed in part. Resolved: That that part of chapter 77 of the resolves of 1939 which provides for a state pension for Mary Kane of Bangor, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.

Chapter 121

RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Bessie King.

Resolves, 1925, c. 48; repealed. Resolved: That chapter 48 of the resolves of 1925, providing for a state pension for Bessie King, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.

Chapter 122

RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Mary A. Moulton.

Resolves 1915, c. 304; repealed. Resolved: That chapter 304 of the resolves of 1915, providing for a state pension for Mary A. Moulton, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.
