As Passed by the Ninetieth Legislature

(Effective July 26, 1941)

in repairing the road beginning at the end of the special resolve road, so-called, by the barn of Frank Waterman, and running in a southwesterly direction on state aid road number 4; from the unexpended appropriation made by chapter 86 of the resolves of 1939 in favor of the city of Rockland for the realignment of route 17.

Chapter 127

RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Rockland.

City of Rockland; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2000 in favor of the city of Rockland to be expended during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, to aid in repairing "Broadway", so-called, from the unexpended appropriation made by chapter 86 of the resolves of 1939 in favor of the city of Rockland for the realignment of route 17.

Chapter 128

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of St. George.

Town of St. George; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of St. George the sum of \$2500 to be expended during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1942, from the unexpended appropriation made by chapter 86 of the resolves of 1939 in favor of the city of Rockland for the realignment of route 17, to build the road from Wallston to the Turkey Cove road, so-called, in the town of St. George.

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Charleston.

Town of Charleston; appropriation for. Resolved: That the appropriation made by the 89th Legislature in favor of the town of Charleston to aid in repairing Puddle Dock road, so-called, in that town, be and hereby
