As Passed by the Ninetieth Legislature

(Effective July 26, 1941)

Chapter 135

RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph L. Perry, of Rumford.

Joseph L. Perry; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$3,000 to be paid to Joseph L. Perry, of Rumford, as a settlement in full for all claims against the state for damages sustained by reason of the negligence of the state; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.

Chapter 136

RESOLVE, for the Purchase of Copies of "The Old Man of the 103rd".

"The Old Man of the 103rd"; purchase of copies. Resolved: That the state purchase 300 copies of the book entitled "The Old Man of the 103rd" written by Colby L. McIntyre, at a price of 50c per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the state librarian; and that there be, and hereby is, appropriated for this purpose the sum of \$150.

Chapter 137

RESOLVE, Providing for the Payment of Certain Pauper Claims.

Claims, appropriation in payment of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the cities, towns, counties and persons hereinafter named, the sums set opposite their respective names, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of \$46,001.06, being the amounts recommended by the committee on claims.

City of Auburn, for expenses incurred in the support of Elmer L. Connick, a pauper	848.26
Majorie Barry, R. N., of Bangor, for nursing service rendered Martha and Frank Buker, minor children of Robert Buker, a pauper	46.00
City of Bangor, for support of state dependents	4,634.05
