PUBLIC LAWS

1943

Sec. 3. P. L., 1939, c. 292, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 292 of the public laws of 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Newspaper space required. Such ~~published report~~ condensed summary shall not require newspaper space in excess of a 6 column page or its equivalent.'

Chapter 173

AN ACT Relating to Limitation of Use of Vehicles Under Dealers' Registration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 60, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 60 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'No motor truck, tractor, or trailer registered under this section shall be used for other than demonstration, service, or emergency purposes.'

Chapter 174

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Register of Deeds of Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 44, amended. The 7th paragraph of section 44 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Kennebec, ~~two thousand dollars~~ \$2,200.'

Sec. 2. Limitation of act. This act shall remain in force for a period of 2 years only. It is the intent of the legislature to change the present statute for a period of 2 years only, after which period the statute shall return to full force and effect.
